

Climate Action Requires fighting for Justice and Upholding Rights

We PENGON FoE Palestine as a movement fighting against systems of injustice that view indigenous peoples as disposable, to be sacrificed by racist and colonial systems of exploitation, we see the struggle of the Palestinian people against occupation and apartheid as part of our collective struggle for climate, racial, economic and political justice.

The struggle against colonial regime is connected with the struggles against other oppressive regimes for human rights, social and climate justice struggles. COP28 is committing greenwashing strategy for the oppression systems, and Promoting Companies Involved in Israeli Crimes. While the current Israeli government, the most far-right, racist, and fundamentalist ever, intensifies its colonial settlement policies and apartheid against the Palestinian people, UAE embraced cooperation with Israel.

Palestine is a cause of human rights and climate justice. The defence of our land and resources, and our opposition to Israeli greenwashing companies and institutions are part of our liberation struggle, which is inherently linked to global struggles for Indigenous rights, land rights and the struggle against the fossil fuel industry and climate colonialism.

The intensity of the assaults to which we are now bearing witness that is being carried out by Israel's occupation forces against the Palestinian people, lands and civilian infrastructure is not without context, but rather rooted in over 75 years of dehumanizing settler colonial violence. In the midst of carrying out the relentless bombardment of Gaza, Israel approved 12 new licenses to 6 oil and gas corporations to conduct exploratory drilling of reserves off the coast of Gaza

as a Palestinian I plan not to attend COP 28 that deflect criticism from Israeli's system of oppression against Palestinians by projecting Israeli technology as a significant player in international efforts against climate change, while currently commits environmental genocide by using tens of thousands of tons of internationally banned bombs against Gaza, and killing all life elements. Therefore, by which standard or measure, we can talk about achieving climate justice for all!
